Tree planting days for Leadbeater's Possum
Saturday 9th and Sunday 10th May 2009



Join us for a day or two if you're keen, revegetating habitat in the Yellingbo State Faunal Reserve – home of 3 Victorian Emblems – Leadbeater's Possum, Helmeted Honeyeater and the Pink Heath.

- Meet at Yellingbo nursery office at **9.30am**, finish no later than 4pm - **Melway reference 305 G11**;
- No age limit, but any one under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or designated guardian;
- Please bring a 4WD if you have one – we are car pooling into the Reserve. Parks Victoria staff will bring 2 vehicles which can take passengers too;
- **BYO lunch** and drinks – afternoon tea will be provided;
- Bring gumboots or waders if you have them, insect repellent, sunscreen, hat, change of shoes (just in case!), gloves & raincoat. All planting tools will be supplied. Binoculars optional (for bird watching);
